

Player Transfer Policy

Requests for Transfer within Co Armagh.

- A player who wishes to leave our Club to join another club in Co. Armagh must apply in writing to the Club Secretary.

Inter-County Transfers.

- A player who wishes to play for a Club in another county must satisfy requirements relating to permanent residency.
- A player who Transfers from our Club to play for a club in another county, and subsequently within two years transfers back to Co. Armagh, shall rejoin our club

The Executive Committee will consider the application for Transfer and reserves the right to grant or not to grant the application..

The Executive Committee may delegate to a sub-committee the authority to deal with the application for Transfer but shall retain the right to make a final adjudication on an application.

To help with considering the application the committee may take account of some or all of the **Factors for consideration** set out below.

A Transfer becomes effective when granted by the appropriate committee.

In the event of an executive decision not to grant a Transfer the player[s] shall have the right to have the case determined by the County Board.

Factors for consideration; *Intended destination; Reason for request; Membership and registration status; Length of time as a playing member; Length of time since last played for Club; Status on the particular team; Relationship with team members; Links with Club; Views of parents/family; Players contribution to overall Club development; Previous requests.*
